



Covid19 Guidelines for Bus Travel from 1 June 2020

OCCUPANCY RATE WHEN TRAVELLING BY BUS

1. No more than 30 passengers can be transported in a 50-seater (and larger capacities) bus;
2. For smaller seating capacities such as 16 seats, 25 seats etc. no more than 50% occupancy by the number of available seats. For example: 50% for a 25-seater bus is no more than 12 passengers;
3. Passengers up to and including 12 years of age: 1 on 1 seat. See below for more information: Guidelines FOR OUR YOUNG TRAVELLERS;

GUIDELINES FOR OUR TRAVELLERS

1. You must wear a (non-medical) mask in the bus. This is not required for passengers up to 12 years of age;
2. Take care of each other, keep as much distance as possible and bring your own hand gel on board the bus if you wish;
3. Follow the well-known Corona hygiene rules as communicated by The Government; these include: do not travel on the bus when you have a fever, have a cold and/or cough. In that case, you must stay at home;
4. Strictly follow the rules for getting on and off the bus:
 - a. Get on and off the bus via the (middle) door.
 - b. Get on and off the bus one at a time.
 - c. Give each other space and maintain a distance of least 1.5 metres when getting in and out.
 - d. When getting on the bus, move as far as possible away from the door and then sit down.
5. Do not walk around the (driving) bus, you must always stay as far apart as possible.
6. Follow the driver's instructions. If you do not comply with the above guidelines and/or instructions provided by the driver, the driver may deny you access to the bus;

GUIDELINES FOR YOUNG TRAVELLERS UP TO AND INCLUDING 12 YEARS OF AGE

In addition to the above: primary school children can travel on a bus from 11 May 2020 without having to maintain a distance of 1.5 metres. This applies to the distance between children. As much distance as possible is to be kept between the children, the teachers and any supervisors. The distance from the driver remains 1.5 metres; also for children. Children up to and including the age of 12 do not have to wear a mask (see also above);
